Test Window Reminders

2025 - 26 OSAS Statewide Summative Test Spring Window

The test window for the statewide summative content assessments applies to all versions of the tests: online General (in-person and remote) and Alternate (Oregon Extended; in-person only).

- The statewide administration window for the **OSAS Science Tests in grades 5 and 8 is open as of March 3, 2026.**
- The statewide administration window for the remote **English Language Proficiency Assessment (ELPA) Summative Test is open as of March 3, 2026.**
- The statewide administration window for the **Future K ELPA Screener is open as of March 3, 2026.**
- The statewide administration window for the **OSAS English Language Arts (ELA) and Math Tests in grades 3 - 8 opens on March 31, 2026.**

As a reminder, prior to beginning a test session, verify that appropriate student accommodations and supports have been accurately set in TIDE. See the [Oregon Accessibility Manual](#) for more information about accommodations and supports.



Remote Test Administration

Students who will be testing remotely must have the Remote Tester button set to “yes” and the Parent Consent for A/V Monitoring must be selected. Contact your [Regional ESD Partner](#) for assistance uploading the remote test settings into TIDE.

To administer tests to students who are remote, **TAs must complete the and pass the [Remote Test Administration Certification Course](#).**

This course is only required for those TAs who will be administering the remote testing session.



Test Improprieties: DTC Investigation and Reports

A thorough investigation and report will result in faster resolution

Example: Student stood up and walked to his phone where TA had it stored and began texting. He was away from his test when he was texting since his phone was on the opposite side of the room and when TA turned her back for a quick second to grab a piece of paper he quietly walked over and picked up his phone.

Fortunately, he was the only student in the room and TA stopped the test session immediately. TA checked his phone and confirmed that he was texting his mom to come pick him up from school and was not using the phone to check the answers. TA then called parents to double check and it was also confirmed.

A less detailed report will take longer to resolve, as ODE will need to reach out for more information

Example: Student had a cell phone.

To support the district's recommended outcome, please confirm what your investigation supports (TAM 3.6):

- Did or will the student receive an unfair advantage or disadvantage?
- Was or will there be a test security issue?
- Is there potential harm, trauma, or undue hardship for the student?

ELPA: IDEA non-compliance and domain tests

For impropriety purposes, “IDEA non-compliance” means a test was not administered according to a student’s IEP.

- **Example:** The IEP says “exempt Reading” but the student opened a Reading domain test.

IEP team exemption decisions apply to unopened domain tests.

- **Example:** The student opened a Listening test but did not yet open Reading. The IEP team may exempt Reading and the test will remain IDEA compliant.

New IEP team exemption decisions do not apply to previously opened domain tests.

- **Example:** The student opens a Reading domain test. Five seconds later, the IEP team decides to exempt Reading. This decision will apply to next year’s test, but is too late for this year’s test.

Thank you DTCs

ELPA is a complicated test.

For years now ODE has asked DTCs to take special actions and remember special exceptions for ELPA. This work can sometimes be invisible to students, families, and many colleagues.

DTCs do it anyway because they care about students.

SEED Survey Administration

- Reminder: All districts are required by law to make the SEED and Alt-SEED Survey available to students in grades 3-11
- “Make available” is language from [ORS 329.078](#), the 2023 law passed by the Oregon legislature
 - The survey is “made available” by districts as described in the [SEED Survey Administration Manual](#). [OAR 581.022.2100](#) requires that survey administration follow the SEED Survey Administration Manual guidelines.

Test Record Updates

- 2/19/2026 [ARUA Training](#) is now available.
- ELA and Math scores will be available in ARUA on March 17
 - Scores will be released approximately two weeks after a student completes both the CAT and PT portions of the test
- Science scores are available in ARUA now
 - Scores will be released approximately two days after the test has been submitted
- ELPA Summative Data Delivery Schedule:

Batch	Test Completion Dates	Data Delivery to Districts**
1	1/13 – 1/31	3/13
2	2/1 – 2/28	4/7
3	3/1 – 3/31	5/11
4	4/1 – 4/11	6/1

*If volume is high, batch delivery to districts could be delayed.

**Scores will be available in ARUA the following Tuesday.

SB141 Interim Test Requirement Information

Select an Interim Test

The interim test must be selected from the list adopted by the State Board of Education.

Administer the Interim Test

Interim tests for language arts and math must be administered 3 times per year in grades K-8.

Review Data

Interim test data must be reviewed at least 3 times per year with administrators from each school and during a public meeting for the superintendent and school board.
