Updates and Reminders

- Alt ELPA and ELPA Summative window closes 4/12.
- ELPA Screener item counter error: some ELPA Screeners in late March/early April displayed an unusually high maximum item numbers. This is a display error only and should be fixed. Students did not receive additional items.
- "Provisionally Proficient": ODE analyzing feedback from COSA Multilingual and English Learner conference and from Title III Office Hours. Final decision currently expected in April.
- ELPA Summative Batch 2 scores are now available. See AA Update for more information.
 - CRS reports are unofficial. ODE applications are official.

More Updates and Reminders

- Remote settings need to be activated in TIDE, and a parent permission form completed, prior to testing. Contact your Regional ESD Partner for assistance uploading the remote test settings into TIDE.
- As the full OSAS ELA and Math Test Window opens, please remind educators about pausing Performance Tasks vs. "End Test" to avoid accidental submissions.
- Remember to return completed PreACT tests by April 19.

Setting Accommodations and Supports

- Ensuring accessibility for all students:
 - Review and Confirm student accommodations and designated supports prior to the start of the the test.
 - Accessibility is a shared duty.
 - Designated supports and Accommodations not set correctly before students begin testing can significantly impact the student testing experience.
