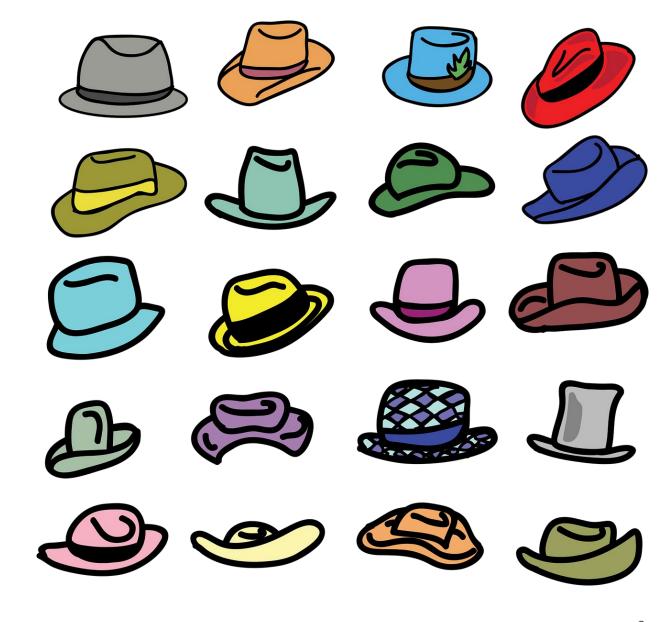

Setting Accommodations and Supports

Ensuring Accessibility for All Students:

Before testing begins, carefully review and confirm each student's accommodations and designated supports.

If accommodations or supports are not correctly set **before** students begin testing, it can result in:

- Students not receiving the tools they need to complete the test.
- Increased frustration, anxiety, or confusion during testing.
- Incomplete or invalid test results.
- Test resets, requiring students to retake the assessment and causing loss instructional time.

Honoring Student Proficiency on the HS ELPA Summative

- Context: ODE requested to renew and extend its policy <u>Honoring Student</u>
 <u>Proficiency on the HS ELPA Summative</u>
- US Dept of Education has requested that ODE hold public comment.
- Materials are in preparation; public comment will be invited for a three-week period.
- Public comment announcement will be disseminated through appropriate communication channels (but not A&A Update because the comment period begins next week).
