Question: Are the OSAS Math Interim Assessment Blocks (IABs) aligned with Oregon's 2021 K-12 Math Standards? (1/2)

OSAS Math IABs are **not yet fully aligned** with the 2021 Oregon K-12 Math Standards.

- ODE has prioritized the alignment of the summative blueprint and item pool
- Still a high degree of alignment in grades 3 6, moderate alignment in grades 7 8
- ODE anticipates IABs aligned with OR standards will be available in SY 2026-27

Question 1: Opt-Outs & Exemptions

Q: On what date(s) will ODE copy the opt-outs/exemptions from TIDE into ARUA? And if a district does coding in ARUA before ODE copies from TIDE, will the copy overwrite what has been done manually?

A: The first load of opt-outs from TIDE into the ARUA will be on Friday, May 30 and will occur every Friday through the end of the assessment validation window (August 22). No, ODE will not overwrite existing codes in the ARUA with data from TIDE.

Question 2: Opt-Outs & Exemptions

Q: Is there a streamlined way to process invalidations due to opt-out/exemption request submitted after testing? With opt-outs/exemptions are recorded in TIDE, could this be automated rather than having STCs submit improprieties for each test?

A: Full automation is not currently available; more investigation is needed. Our vendor (Cambium) suggested this manual workaround:

- 1. Run a district-wide search of all students with Parent Opt-Outs in TIDE (Search Students Module).
- 2. Drop that list of SSIDs in the Participation by SSID module.
- 3. Filter the results by any tests that are not already invalidated.
- 4. Submit a bulk invalidation request to ODE via the existing process using the Smartsheet, but attaching a list of SSIDs/Results IDs.

Configuring ChromeOS Workstations

Our test delivery vendor Cambium Assessment (CAI) highly recommends that districts consult their information on configuring ChromeOS Workstations

- ChromeOS updates can introduce bugs that interfere with testing
- Limiting update frequency ensures that Chromebooks remain compatible throughout the test window
- Following CAI recommendations will reduce unneeded Helpdesk calls


Honoring Student Proficiency Public Comment Closed

- The public comment period has now closed on ODE's proposal to renew and expand Honoring Student Proficiency on the HS ELPA Summative.
- 118 responses
 - 117 in favor; 1 abstention; 0 in opposition
 - 73 respondents added comments (we read every one)

Test Administration Manual Update Process

- Preliminary Test Administration Manual published by August 1
 each year
- Approved by State Board of Education in August or September
- Final Test Administration Manual published by October 1 each year
- DTCs or any other user may signal errors or omissions year-round by emailing <u>ode.assessmentteam@ode.oregon.gov</u>
 - Mid-year updates only when necessary
 - Minor corrections will appear in the next year's edition

Alt ELPA and ELPA Summative Test Group Permissions

Test group permissions govern which tests TAs have the ability to select in the test delivery system (and therefore which tests they can administer).

Currently: the ELPA Summative test group permission includes Alt ELPA and ELPA Summative.

Proposed change: split the ELPA Summative test group into ELPA Summative and Alt ELPA. TAs would need the ELPA Summative test group to administer the ELPA Summative, the Alt ELPA test group to administer the Alt ELPA, and both test groups if they wanted to administer both.

Districts must have an additional person designated (Information Only Contact) to receive weekly updates via email from ODE and who can be trained to fill in for the DTC in their absence. This additional "information only" person DOES NOT have access to secure data information unless the district requests this access separate from this form.
