# Reminder: Statewide Assessment Reporting Webinar (cont'd)

## OSAS Webinar: *Effectively Using 2022 - 23 Summative Assessment Data to Inform Continuous Improvement*

ODE is excited to demonstrate a **NEW** multi-year cross-sectional report within the Reporting System that displays up to a three-year trend of target-level data. This automates the creation of “target trend reports” that ODE has been promoting since 2019.

# Reminders: Test Impropriety Process

Reminder: Test Impropriety Deadline Friday 6/16/23 (12:00PM)

## Goals:

- More tightly link test record changes to test-related behaviors
- Increase opportunity for students to show what they know and can do
  - Changes were *not* related to participation rate concerns

## Issues to keep in mind for 2023-24:

- Accidental submissions (pause / end test button)
- Internet capable devices in the testing environment
  - Training and prevention
  - ODE will look for ways to add clarity to TAM language

# Reminders: Official Individual Student Report

ODE provides ISRs for ELA, Math, Science, and ELPA statewide summative tests to schools and districts via the [Secure Assessment Reports 2.0](#) application.

- Currently available in English and Spanish and are ADA compliant
- Parents or guardians may request from schools and districts a *written or oral translation* of the ISR in their respective language or a language they understand

***Districts may choose to produce and provide an ISR to parents or guardians in lieu of using ODE's ISR.*** The district's ISR must meet the same federal and state requirements as ODE's ISR (i.e., timeliness, content, accessibility, and translation).

# Legal Last Name Logins for State Testing

Presently, students log into the OSAS testing system using their legal first name and SSID.

Beginning August 1, 2023, students will log in using their **legal last name** and SSID.

This will reduce potential harm of unexpectedly confronting students with information they do not wish to see in their “legal first name” field.

Note that login must *exactly* match information in the legal last name field (including accents and other special characters).

# Updating DTC Responsibilities List

- A concern was raised in April that ODE documentation did not adequately communicate some of the larger DTC job responsibilities
- Worked with ESD partners and a small DTC focus group that included representatives from each region as well as new and experienced DTCs
- Result: identified what additions and changes needed to be made
- Next step: documents (e.g. TAM, DTC checklist, and training materials where needed) will be updated and published in September

# Clarification for Parent Opt-Out and Impact on Participation & Performance Announcement

## The Why...

- [ORS 329.479: Student Assessment Bill of Rights](#) give parents the ability to opt their children out of participating in the statewide summative assessment.
- Participation includes reporting, as well, for example, in the case where a student has been accidentally tested.

## Who does this impact...

- Tests that were started or finished in ELA and math and the school has a signed opt out form



# Clarification for Parent Opt-Out and Impact on Participation & Performance Announcement (cont'd)

## Parent Opt-Out and Impact on Participation & Performance Announcement

- The [Assessment Inclusion Rules Manual](#) was updated and posted on June 2nd with the following information:
  - a) Cases where students tested in ELA or Math even though there was a signed Opt-out form on file shall be reported as testing improprieties via the usual Test Impropriety Reporting System, and any tests started will be invalidated in Cambium's system.
  - b) Test records with an Administration Code of X and enough item responses to meet the threshold for participation will be invalidated.
- The changes go into effect for this 22-23 school year and will remain in effect for future years.
