Updates (1/3)

- Complete this [2024-25 Summer Contact Information Google form](#).
- The Oregon Accessibility Panel (OAP) and Alternate Assessment Advisory Panel (AAAP) are recruiting for new panel members for 2025-26. Please consult the [June A&A Update](#) for details.
- Reminder: ELTC Advisory Panel recruitment process closes this Friday, June 13, 2025. See May and [June's A & A Update](#) for details. Pass along to early learning and kindergarten staff in your districts.
- ODE requires that districts annually designate a District Test Coordinator (DTC) using the [DTC and Information Only Contact Form](#). District signed [superintendent form](#) must be attached, due June 20, 2025.

Updates (2/3)

- Last day to submit extended assessments is June 13, 2025.
- Merge ELPA Temp IDs to SSIDs No Later Than July 19, 2025.
- Assessment validation window June 12-August 22
 - English language arts student performance
 - Mathematics student performance
 - Science Next Gen student performance
- On-Track to English language proficiency validation July 24-August 22

Updates (3/3)

- The test status change deadline has passed for ELPA Summative and Alt ELPA. No further changes can be made to test records in TIDE. The test status change for ELA, Math, and Science is 6/20/25.
- ODE's Honoring Student Proficiency renewal request was approved by the US Department of Education. The guidance will be updated.
 - Approved: extension into grades 6-8, adding Alt ELPA grades 6-8 and 9-12, and "freezing" carried elements so they cannot be pulled down in future years.

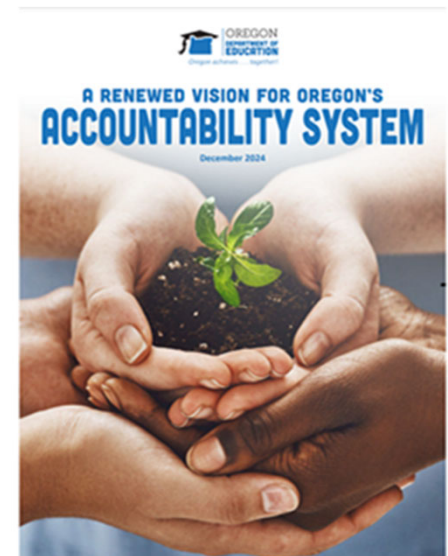
Legislative Update: SB 141/HB 2009 (1/2)

[SB 141B](#)/[HB2009A](#):

Interims

- State Board of Education required to adopt up to 4 interim tests by January 31, 2026
- ODE developing interim quality criteria that will be used to evaluate proposed interims consisting of:
 - Ed Reports Interim Criteria for ELA and Math (Grades 3-8)
 - Oregonized criteria
- Current plan is to publish a Request for Information for vendor response by end of July

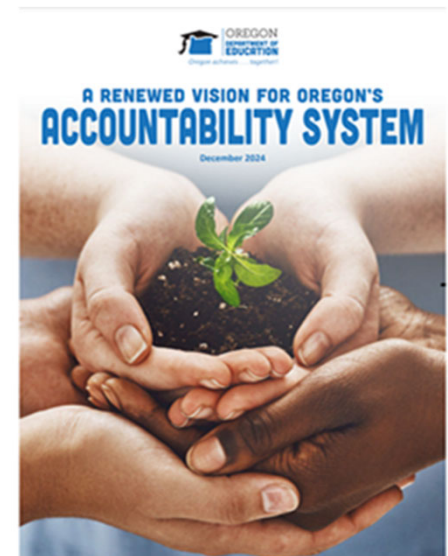

Reporting Requirements

Starting in 2026-27...

- Districts must administer interim tests three times per year in English language arts and mathematics
- Results from those administrations must be reported during school board meetings, allowing for public comment
- Results must also be shared with ODE

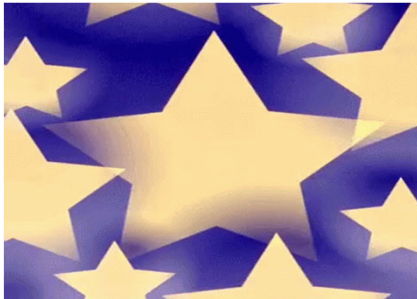

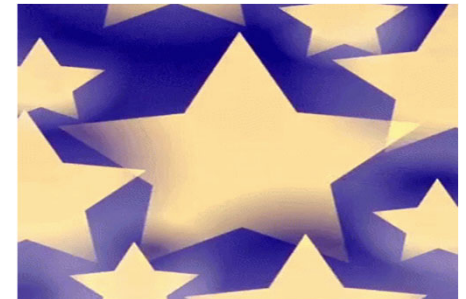
How did your district choose to make the SEED Survey available?

- Non-participation/virtual test records are loading weekly (except the week after July 4) through August 22.
- ELA and math results load after CAT and PT are submitted (within ten business days of PT completion).
- Science results load within one business day of test completion.
- June 27- Partial test records for science
- June 27- Extended assessments
- July 11- Partial test records for ELA and math
