Accountability and Reporting

1. When are Individual Student Reports (ISRs) available?
 - a. Many official ODE ISRs are available now. As of July 10th, all tests should be scored and loaded into the ODE applications. If using the unofficial ISRs in the OSAS Portal, those are available on a nightly basis, accounting for ELA and Math hand-scoring. ISRs in the OSAS Portal are not official and validation has not been completed. This distinction between official and unofficial scores matters particularly for the ELPA.
2. What is the final date for all assessment records to load in ODE data applications?
 - a. 7/10/26.
3. Are there any reports in ODE data applications that are not final?
 - a. Virtual test records are not final. All other records in ODE data applications are final.
4. What are virtual test records and how do they work?
 - a. Any student enrolled on May 1st who doesn't have a valid test record will receive a virtual record. The virtual record will remain until a valid test record loads for that subject. For a short period of time, students may have both a valid test record and a virtual record. As the data continues to refresh, the virtual record will drop off and only the valid test record will remain.

Accountability and Reporting: ELPA and Alt ELPA

5. Does ODE plan to address the discrepancies between Individual Student Reports (ISRs) for the English Language Proficiency Assessment (ELPA) Summative as displayed in the Centralized Reporting System (CRS) vs. official ODE data applications?

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- a. We have nothing to report at this time, but we are aware these discrepancies have been a pain point for years and are actively looking for solutions.

6. Which elements remain in TIDE after the system rollover?
 - a. All accounts in TIDE will remain from year to year. All test groups are removed except for the ELPA Screener and Interim test groups.

Training and Materials

7. Are ODE assessment manual publication dates estimates or guarantees?
 - a. The Test Administration Manual (TAM), Oregon Accessibility Manual (OAM), and SEED Survey Administration Manual (SAM) 8/1 and 10/1 publication dates are hard deadlines. We commit to publishing on or prior to those dates.
