Alt-ELPA

- 1. When will Alt ELPA ISRs be available?
 - a. Alt ELPA ISRs will be available in the Secure Assessment Reports. If district's need access to Alt ELPA ISRs before they are available in SAR, they may reach out to their Regional ESD Partner for support.
 - b. A DTC Listserv message was sent on 6/17 with more information.

ELPA

- 2. When will the approved extensions to the Honoring Student Proficiency policy take effect?
 - a. Eligible scores from 2024-25 tests will be carried on the ELPA Summative and Alt ELPA for grades 6-8 and 9-12.

ORExt

- 3. Where do we check completion for students who took extended testing?
 - a. ORExt completion can be monitored in the OR.K12test.com website.

PreACT

- 4. Can the PreACT window be modified to better align with SAT School Day?
 - a. The 2025 -26 PreACT window is open continuously from 9/30/25 through 4/10/26. The PreACT can be administered at any time during that window, which should align with the SAT School Day window in October and most of the spring SAT School Day

- window (which typically opens in early March, according to the College Board website).
- b. The PreACT window cannot be extended beyond 4/10/26. The 24-25 administration year was a unique exception due to the delayed start of the window because of the ACT/IntermediaryEd transition.
