### Q&A Session:

#### *Accountability*

**Q: Is there training on how to do accountability and validation?**

A: The [AA Checklist](#), found on the [Key Dates for Accountability and Reporting page](#), has links to [videos](#) that will help with the accountability process.

Region One Assessment Consortium (ROAC) also has this [After Testing training slide deck](#) for DTCs.

**Q: When will the non participation reports be available in the ARUA?**

A: Non-participation records will be available in ARUA on June 14th. The test completion report will not open again until June 14th.

**Q: Some collections are not currently visible in ARUA. When will those collections be available again?**

A: June 14th.

**Q: Some score reports are not currently available in Secure Assessment Reports 2.0. When will those score reports become available?**

A: June 14th.

**Q: Does participation data shared during the 6/8 DTC webinar include extended tests?**

A: No, the graph displayed did not include extended tests.

## **ELPA**

### **Q: Where can I retrieve ELPA Summative reports?**

A: ELPA Summative score reports available in two places.

- [Secure Assessment Reports \(SAR\)](#) has the official, final version of ELPA Summative score reports. Results that have been rescored (for example, because of Honoring Student Proficiency on the HS ELPA Summative) are posted here.
- The Centralized Reporting System (CRS) provides preliminary, unofficial reports. Rescores are *not* reflected in CRS reports.

### **Q: Scoring should be completed for all ELPA Summative batches. When will score reports be available in Secure Assessment Reports?**

A: June 14th.

## **TIDE**

### **Q: When Test Information Distribution Engine (TIDE) accounts roll over at the change of the school year, will staff need to create new passwords?**

A: Yes; please refer to the [TIDE User Guide](#) for additional information (p.7).

### **Q: Will TAs need to repeat the remote certification course after the TIDE roll over?**

A: Yes; TAs will need to take the OSAS Portal Remote Certification Course in order to have remote testing capabilities added to their account. This feature will not be part of the roll over process.

### **Q: What is the Partial load date?**

A: Test records from Partial tests will be available in the Assessment Record Updating Application (ARUA) on the ODE district secure website.

Partials for Science are scheduled to load on July 1. Partials for ELA and Math are scheduled to load on or before July 12.

**Q: I am only getting ELA on my Combined ISRs. Is that because of the extended window or just a glitch with the system?**

A: The Secure Assessment Reports application is being updated to work with the new transactional system. The combined ISRs will be fixed to include all subjects.

**Q: Is there a quick way to see exactly which students a district is responsible for testing if it is not up to date in TIDE?**

A: You can use the ODE Participation Report in the ARUA to get counts of students who are flagged as non-participants, once the 2021-22 subjects are available again on June 14.

**Q: Could the TIDE system flag students who are no longer at our district but have not yet been claimed by another district, so as to exclude the student from participation calculations?**

A: ODE is discussing this issue internally and with our testing vendor.

### *Training*

**Q: Do TAs need to complete Interim or ELPA Screener for the next school year, or once they do it they are good to go from year to year?**

A: TA training for the Interims and the ELPA Screener needs to be completed each calendar year, but districts can schedule that training to (for example) coincide with other yearly trainings (i.e. it is not necessary for a previously trained TA to immediately retrain right after the summer TIDE rollover)
