

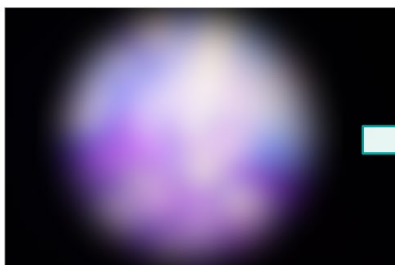
Effectively Using Summative Assessment Data to Inform Continuous Improvement

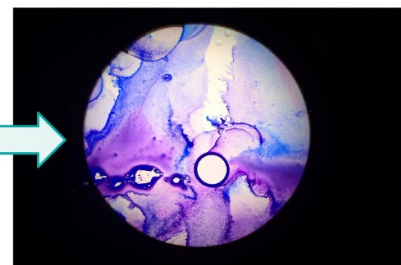
Turn OSAS Results into Meaningful Action

To Target Level Performance



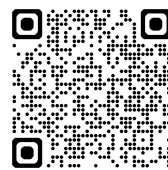
Looking beyond overall results brings student performance into sharper focus, revealing strengths, opportunities for improvement, and insights that can inform continuous improvement.
