Approaches to Learning

The teacher will observe your child during classroom time.

During the first few weeks of kindergarten, the teacher will observe your child doing the following tasks:



Observes rules and follows directions without requiring repeated reminders



Cooperates with playmates when participating in a group play activity, willing to give and take in the group, to listen to or help others



Completes tasks successfully



Complies with adult directives, giving little or no verbal or physical resistance, even with tasks that he/she dislikes
