FAST FACTS: Sense of Belonging - Representation by Grade Band and Student Group

Definition: How students' identities and communities are represented in school.

ODE calculates a **Sense of Belonging - Representation** <u>domain score</u> among 3rd-11th graders that has a possible range of 0 to 100. This score is based off students' responses to 4 items on the <u>SEED Survey</u> (on a 4-point scale with response options being: Never; Rarely; Sometimes; Often):

3rd-11th Grade Items

- Think about your assignments from this school year. How often did they have pictures or stories of people who are like you and your family?
- Think about the tests you took this school year. How often did they have pictures or stories of people who are like you and your family?
- Think about the materials you used in class this school year. These could be textbooks, workbooks, or online materials. How often did they have pictures or stories of people who are like you and your family?
- Think about the things you read in class this school year. These things could be articles, stories, or books. How often did they show people who are like you and your family?


4% of students had a score of 100, meaning that they were often exposed to all of these forms of representation at school

11% of students had a score of 0, meaning that they did not feel that they were ever exposed to any of these forms of representation at school

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Exposure to Representation dropped from elementary to middle school, and increased from middle to high school.

Figure 1: Distribution of Student Domain Scores




| Grade Band | State Domain Score | Equivalency |
|-----------------------------------|---------------------------|--|
| 3 rd -5 th | 43 | Roughly equivalent to responding 'Rarely' to 3 items and 'Sometimes' |
| | | to 1 item |
| 6 th -8 th | 41 | Roughly equivalent to responding 'Rarely' to 3 items and 'Sometimes' |
| | | to 1 item |
| 9 th -11 th | 46 | Roughly equivalent to responding 'Rarely' to 2 items and 'Sometimes' |
| | | to 2 items |

Some student groups consistently had lower domain scores across all grade bands:

- Male students
- American Indian/Alaska Native students
- Multiracial students

Note. The dark green circle indicates the state-level score for each group, and the light green box indicates the score range across districts in Oregon with at least 10 responses. The vertical black line indicates the state-level score for all students combined.
