FAST FACTS: Well-Rounded Education by Grade Band and Student Group

Definition: Students' access to classes that are interesting and meaningful to them.

ODE calculates a **Well-Rounded Education** <u>domain score</u> among 7th-11th graders that has a possible range of 0 to 100. This score is based off students' responses to 4 items on the <u>SEED Survey</u> (on a 4-point scale with response options being: Strongly disagree, Disagree, Agree, Strongly agree). Items are:

7th-11th Grade Items

Think about this school year and the courses available at your school. How much do you agree with each statement?

- I have opportunities to take courses that align with my interests.
- I am taking courses that align with my interests.
- I have opportunities to take courses that will help me achieve my future goals.
- I am taking courses that will help me achieve my future goals.


14% of students had a score of 100, meaning that they strongly agreed with all items

4% of students had a score of 0, meaning that they strongly disagreed with all items

Figure 1: Distribution of Student Domain Scores




| Grade Band | State Domain Score | Equivalency |
|-----------------------------------|---------------------------|--|
| 7 th -8 th | 59 | Roughly equivalent to responding 'Agree' to 3 items, and 'Disagree' to 1 |

| 9 th -11 th | 69 | Roughly equivalent to responding 'Agree' to all items |

Some student groups consistently had lower domain scores across both grade bands:

- Male students
- American Indian/Alaska Native students
- Multiracial students

- White students
- Students experiencing poverty
- Students experiencing homelessness

Note. The dark green circle indicates the state-level score for each group, and the light green box indicates the score range across districts in Oregon with at least 10 responses. The vertical black line indicates the state-level score for all students combined.
