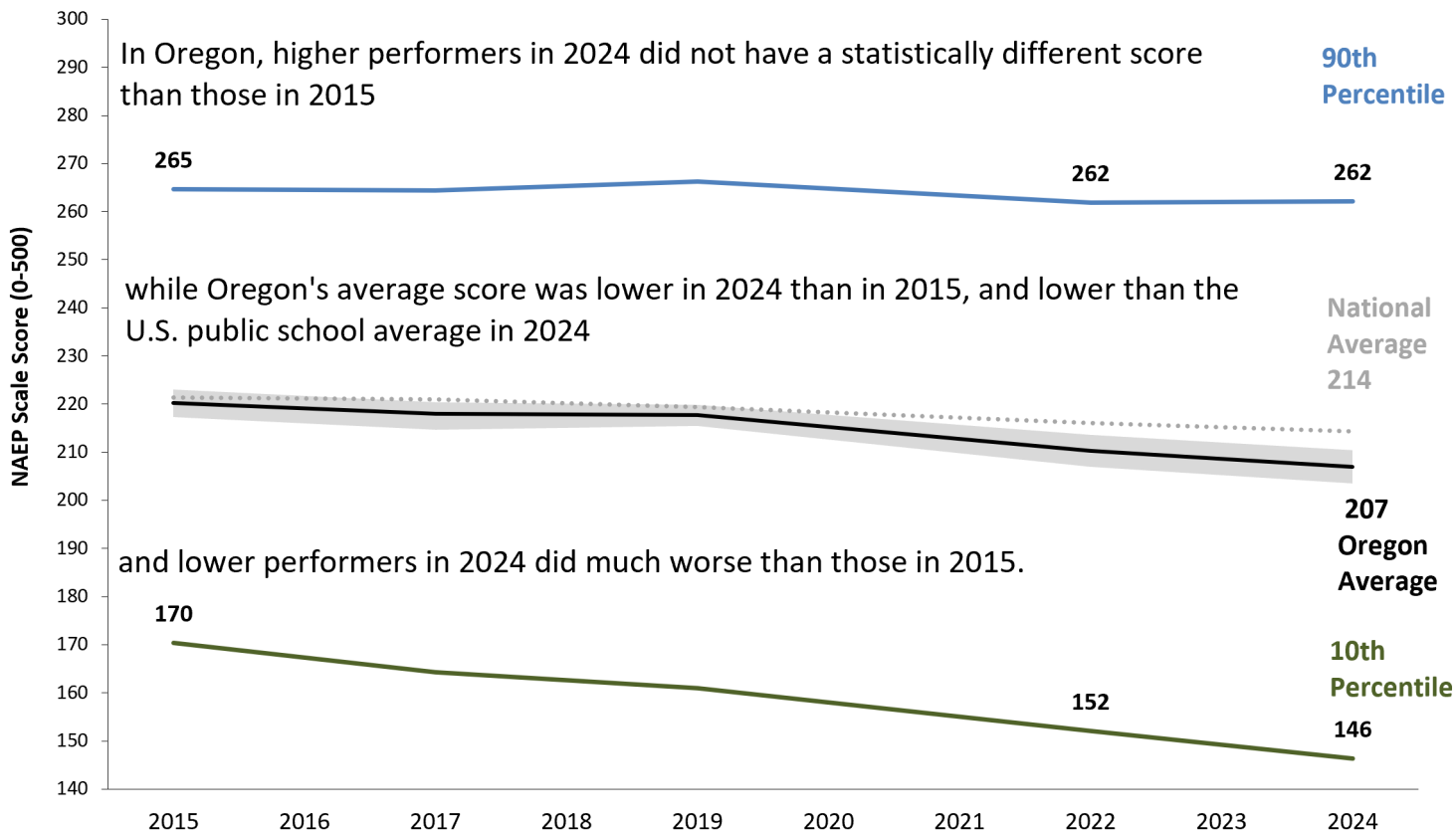


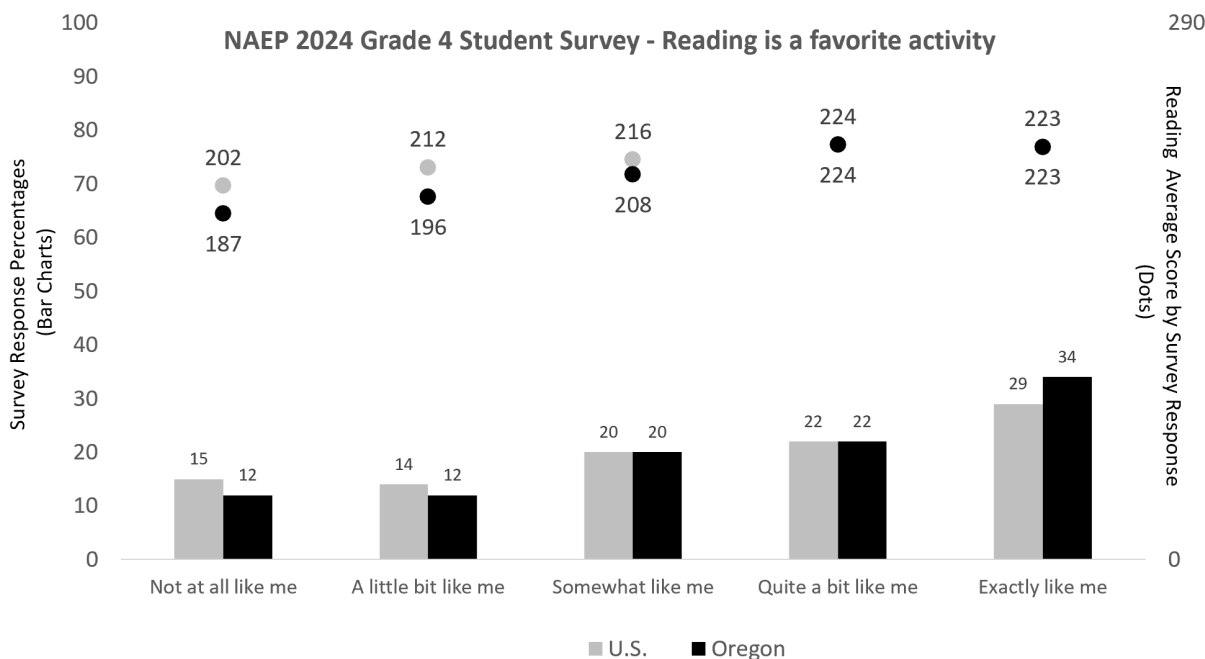

NAEP Grade 4 Reading Results, 2015 — 2024

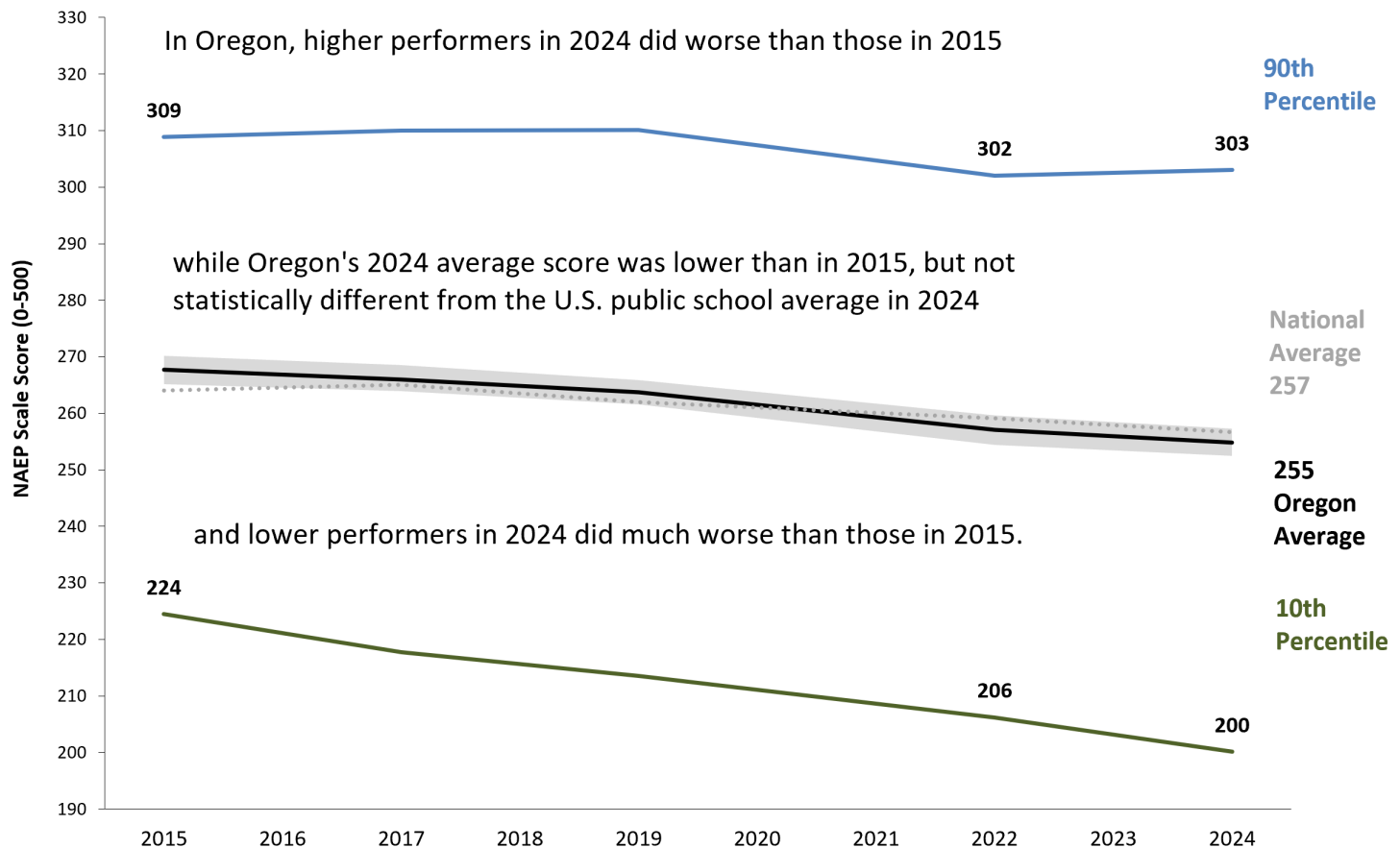


Compared to 4th graders nationally, a lower percentage of Oregon students reported “Reading is a favorite activity” is not at all like me, while a higher percentage said the statement is exactly like me. Oregon 4th graders reporting not at all like me, a little bit like me, and somewhat like me had statistically lower average scores than their peers nationally.

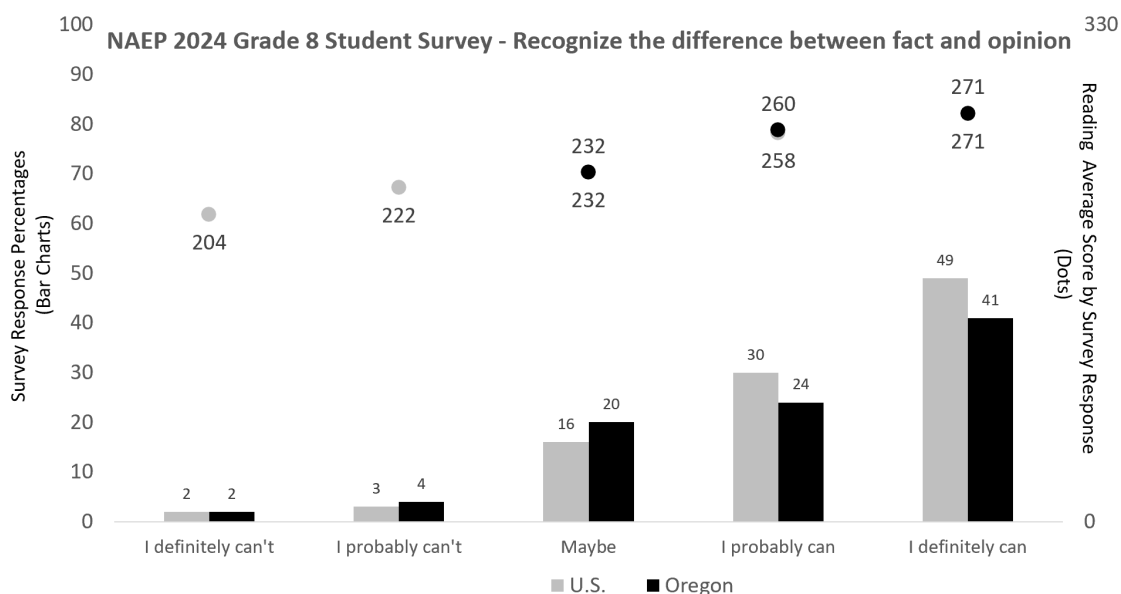




NAEP Grade 8 Reading Results, 2015 — 2024



Compared to 8th graders nationally, a higher percentage of Oregon students reported that they maybe can recognize the difference between fact and opinion, while lower percentages reported that they probably can or definitely can. Note: too few Oregon 8th graders reported definitely can't or probably can't for NAEP to produce average scores for them.
