Professional Development Required Element of Perkins

- Professional Development is a base expectation of Perkins
- Required 10% of total grant be utilized in Professional Development

Professional Development

- Long term sustained effort that leads to a higher level of student engagement and program improvement
- Not the one day workshop
- If XYZ Conference is an event that you want to fund Perkins with you need to tie your professional development plan to the deliverables that are associated with that conference.

Professional Development

- Long range goal
 - Where do you need to be?
 - Advisory Committee / Business and industry input

Professional Development

- Funds budgeted towards professional development are required to stay in the professional development
- Professional development is a sign of leadership
- PD Funds remain in PD
- Complete the Professional Development deliverable.... Funds can not be re-assigned.

Professional Development Funding timing

- Professional Development must occur in the school year that the funds were awarded in.
- Perkins school year – July 1 – June 30.
- If you have summer Professional Development, it needs to be conducted on the front side of the Perkins grant
 - July 1 – August 31

- Secondary & postsecondary programs connected
- Attendance to high school and college events
- OFRI – Trainings (3 annually)
 - Attend 2 of the 3 trainings
- Or
 - OFRI Summer Sustainable Forestry Teacher Tours
