FINDINGS OF FACT

- (1) On July 2, 2010, E.F.'s parents, by and through their attorney, requested a due process hearing. The matter was referred to the Office of Administrative Hearings on July 2, 2010, for hearing, and the matter was assigned to Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) Stephen H. Elmore. A pre-hearing teleconference was set for August 9, 2010.
- (2) ALJ Elmore conducted the August 9, 2010, pre-hearing conference. The parents' attorney and the attorney for the District informed ALJ Elmore that a mediation session had been scheduled for August 26, 2010, and requested waiver of the 45-day deadline to allow the parties to work toward resolution. A second pre-hearing conference was set for August 31, 2010.
- (3) ALJ Elmore conducted the August 31, 2010, pre-hearing conference. The parents' attorney and the attorney for the District informed ALJ Elmore that the parties were moving toward agreement resolving all issues, and that a second mediation session had been scheduled for September 22, 2010. A third pre-hearing conference was set for September 30, 2010.
- (4) The parties subsequently reached resolution of all issues, and on September 27, 2010, the parents' attorney requested that the parents' request for a due-process hearing be dismissed with prejudice. Because no issues remain to be resolved, a contested case proceeding no longer is required.

ORDER

All issues having been resolved, the hearing request of July 2, 2010, is **DISMISSED** with prejudice.
