#### FINDINGS OF FACT

- (1) On July 30, 2010, Parent filed a request for a due process hearing. On August 2, 2010, the Oregon Department of Education referred the request to the Office of Administrative Hearings ("OAH").
- (2) On October 15, 2010, Administrative Law Judge ("ALJ") McGorrin held a Pre-Hearing Conference via telephone. Counsel for Parent, Diane Wiscarson, and counsel for the Salem-Keizer School District, Paul Dakopolos, attended. Counsel advised that they were pursuing settlement discussions. ALJ McGorrin scheduled a further Pre-Hearing Conference for October 22, 2010.
- (3) On October 21, 2010, Ms. Wiscarson sent an email to the OAH. In the email, Ms. Wiscarson stated that Parent and the Salem-Keizer School District reached resolution of the matter. Ms. Wiscarson requested that Parent's due process hearing request be dismissed.

#### ORDER

Parent's request for a due process hearing has been withdrawn and the case is dismissed with prejudice.
