FINDINGS OF FACT

- (1) On February 15, 2011, Parents filed a request for due process hearing with the Oregon Department of Education (Department) on behalf of Parents and Student. The Department referred the request to the Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH) on February 15, 2011. The OAH assigned the case to Senior Administrative Law Judge John Mann.
- (2) ALJ Mann conducted pre-hearing conferences by telephone on March 21, April 1, and May 10, 2011. Parents and student were represented by their attorney, Diane Wiscarson. The District was represented by its attorney, Graham Hicks. The parties requested to waive the 45 day deadline to issue the order in this case and a hearing was scheduled for October 17 through 21, 2011.
- (2) On July 25, 2011, Ms. Wiscarson notified the Office of Administrative Hearings, via e-mail, that the parties had resolved all issues in dispute and requested that the hearing request be dismissed with prejudice.
