FINDINGS OF FACT

- (1) On July 25, 2011, Student's Parents filed a request for due process hearing with the State Superintendent of Public Instruction on behalf of Student.
- (2) On August 31, 2011, Senior Administrative Law Judge Joe L. Allen held a prehearing conference. At the conference, the parties informed ALJ Allen that mediation in this matter was scheduled for September 20, 2011.
- (3) On November 10, 2011, ALJ Allen held a status conference to determine whether any issues remained for hearing after mediation. At the conference, counsel for both parties represented they had reached a tentative agreement. Counsel for Parents, Diane Wiscarson, indicated Parents intended to withdraw the hearing request once all parties had signed the settlement agreement.
- (4) On November 17, 2011, Parents notified the Office of Administrative Hearings, via email, that they wished to withdraw the hearing request with prejudice.

ORDER

The July 25, 2011 request for a due process hearing has been withdrawn and the case is dismissed with prejudice.
