# FINDINGS OF FACT

- (1) On March 23, 2015, Parent filed a request for a due process hearing. On that same date, the Oregon Department of Education referred the request to the Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH).
- (2) A pre-hearing conference was held on April 27, 2015. Parent did not participate in the conference. Attorney Richard G. Cohn-Lee represented the School District. During the conference, Mr. Cohn-Lee reported his understanding that the matter had settled in mediation.
- (3) On April 28, 2015, Parent confirmed to OAH via electronic mail that the parties had successfully resolved the matter in mediation. Parent requested that the due process proceeding be dismissed.

#### **ORDER**

Parent's request for a due process hearing has been withdrawn and the case is dismissed without prejudice.
