#### FINDINGS OF FACT

- (1) On February 10, 2017, Parents filed a request for due process hearing with the State Superintendent of Public Instruction on behalf of D.P. (Student).
- (2) On February 10, 2017, the Department of Education referred the hearing request to the Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH). The OAH assigned Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) Jill Marie Messecar to preside over the hearing in this matter.
