### FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. On February 22, 2019, Kevin Brague, attorney at law, filed a Request for Due Process Hearing with the Oregon Department of Education (ODE). ODE subsequently referred the request to the Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH). The OAH assigned the case to Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) C. Meerdink for hearing.
- 2. On March 8, 2019, Joel Hungerford, attorney at law representing the District, filed a Motion for Sufficiency. On March 11, 2019, Mr. Brague filed a response to the sufficiency motion and an Amended Request for Due Process Hearing. On March 12, 2019, Mr. Hungerford withdrew the District's Motion for Sufficiency.
- 3. On March 13, 2019, ALJ Meerdink emailed the parties and indicated that, because the District had withdrawn its sufficiency motion, that motion would not be addressed. The ALJ also indicated that the student's amended request had restarted the timeline for a resolution period, with the new resolution period ending on April 10, 2019.
- 4. On April 11, 2019, Mr. Brague notified the OAH that the parties had likely reached an agreed resolution, and that the parties would notify OAH when the resolution had been signed and executed.
- 5. On April 29, 2019, Mr. Brague filed a Notice of Dismissal of the Student's Amended Due Process Hearing Request.

### **ORDER**

Parent's March 12, 2019 Amended Request for Due Process Hearing in the above-captioned matter is DISMISSED with prejudice.
