#### FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. On April 15, 2019, Diane Wiscarson, attorney at law, filed a Request for Due Process Hearing with the Oregon Department of Education (ODE) on behalf of Student and Parents. ODE subsequently referred the request to the Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH). The OAH assigned the case to Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) C. Meerdink.
- 2. On May 24, 2019, ALJ Meerdink held a prehearing conference, with Ms. Wiscarson representing Student and Parents, and attorney Joel Hungerford representing the District. During the PHC, the parties notified the ALJ that mediation was scheduled for June 26, 2019. The parties agreed to schedule a hearing for October 7 through 11, 2019, and to extend the 45-day deadline to issue a final order in this case to February 1, 2020.
- 3. On August 6, 2019, both parties notified the OAH via email that they had executed a settlement agreement resolving all matters in this case. Ms. Wiscarson, therefore, requested that Student's Request for Due Process Hearing be dismissed with prejudice.

#### **ORDER**

Student's April 15, 2019 Request for Due Process Hearing in the above-captioned matter is DISMISSED with prejudice.
