FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. On June 3, 2020, attorney Christine Furrer filed a Request for Due Process Hearing with the Oregon Department of Education (ODE) on behalf of Student and Parents. On June 3, 2020, ODE referred the request to the Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH). The OAH assigned the case to Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) C. Meerdink.
- 2. On July 9, 2020, ALJ Meerdink held a prehearing conference (PHC), with Ms. Furrer representing Student and Parents. Parents also participated in the PHC. Mr. Taylor Richman represented the School District. Brian Baker and Mary Mertz also participated for the School District. At the request of both parties, ALJ Meerdink extended the due date for the final order in this case. The parties agreed to hold another PHC to allow for additional time for Ms. Furrer to file an amended hearing request.
- 3. On July 16, 2020, Ms. Furrer filed an Amended Request for Due Process Hearing with ODE. ODE subsequently forwarded on the amended request to OAH.
- 4. On July 23, 2020, ALJ Meerdink held another PHC, with Ms. Furrer representing Student and Parents. Parents also participated in the PHC. Mr. Richman represented the School District. Mr. Baker and Ms. Mertz also participated for the School District. The parties agreed to hold a hearing via video conference October 19 through 23, 2020.
- 5. On October 16, 2020, ALJ Meerdink convened another PHC at the request of the parties. Ms. Furrer and Mr. Richman both requested to cancel the scheduled hearing because the parties had almost completed a settlement agreement. ALJ Meerdink cancelled the hearing.
- 6. On November 2, 2020, Ms. Furrer emailed the OAH a motion to dismiss the amended request with prejudice, as the parties had executed a mediated agreement in the case.

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ORDER

The July 16, 2020 Amended Request for Due Process Hearing in the above-captioned matter is DISMISSED with prejudice.
