### **HISTORY OF THE CASE**

- 1. On August 6, 2020, Parent filed with the Oregon Department of Education (Department) a Request for Due Process Hearing (Complaint) under the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA), the Americans With Disabilities Act (ADA), and Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973 (Section 504) against Redmond School District 2J (District). The Department referred the Complaint to the Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH). The OAH assigned the matter to Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) Jessica E. Toth.
- 2. On August 21, 2020, the District filed a Motion for Determination of Sufficiency of Request for Hearing (Motion). Also on August 21, 2020, Parent filed a Response to Motion for Determination of Sufficiency of Request for Due Process (Response). On August 26, 2020, the OAH issued a ruling on the Motion. On September 17, 2020, Parent filed an Amended Request for Due Process Hearing (Amended Complaint).
- 3. On September 28, 2020, Kevin Brague, counsel for Parent, notified OAH via an email, which included counsel for Redmond School District 2J Melinda Thomas and ODE representative Mike Franklin, that the parties had reached a final resolution and requested that OAH issue a final order dismissing the matter with prejudice.

### **ORDER**

The August 6, 2020 Request for Due Process Hearing and subsequent September 17, 2020 Amended Request for Due Process Hearing in the above-captioned matter are DISMISSED with prejudice and all upcoming dates associated with the matter have been vacated by the OAH.
