FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. On May 28, 2021, Parent filed a Request for Due Process Hearing with the Oregon Department of Education (ODE). ODE subsequently referred the request to the Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH). The OAH assigned the case to Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) Jessica E. Toth for hearing.
- 2. On June 10, 2021, Richard Cohn-Lee, attorney at law representing the District, filed a Motion for Determination of Sufficiency regarding the Request for Due Process Hearing. The ALJ ruled that the Request for Due Process Hearing was sufficient.
- 3. On July 29, 2021, Parent notified the OAH via electronic mail that the parties had reached a resolution of the issue contained in the Request for Due Process Hearing. The ALJ, also through electronic mail, informed the parties that Parent's written communication was accepted as a request to dismiss the due process complaint, and that the complaint would therefore be dismissed unless Parent advised otherwise.
- 4. On July 30, 2021, Parent confirmed via electronic mail that dismissal of the Request for Due Process Hearing was appropriate based on settlement of the sole issue put forth in that complaint.

ORDER

Parent's May 28, 2021 Amended Request for Due Process Hearing in the above-captioned matter is DISMISSED with prejudice. The due process hearing, previously set for September 29 and 30, 2021, is removed from the calendar. OAH retains no further jurisdiction over matter 2021-ABC-04600.
