HISTORY OF THE CASE

On February 24, 2022, counsel for Parents, filed a Due Process Complaint with the Oregon Department of Education (ODE) on behalf of Student D.C. and Parents. ODE subsequently referred the request to the Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH). The OAH assigned the case to Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) Jessica E. Toth for hearing. A due process hearing was scheduled to commence on March 28, 2022.

On March 25, 2022, counsel for Parent submitted a Motion to Dismiss the matter with prejudice, on the basis that the parties had reached a final settlement of all issues.

ORDER

The February 24, 2022 Due Process Complaint in the above-captioned matter is **DISMISSED** with prejudice and all upcoming dates associated with the matter have been vacated by the OAH.
