FINDINGS OF FACT

- (1) On October 9, 2024, Parent of Student filed a request for due process hearing with the Oregon Department of Education (Department) on behalf of Student alleging a denial of a free and appropriate public education (FAPE) under the Individuals with Disabilities in Education Improvement Act (IDEA) by the Salem-Keizer Public Schools (District).
- (2) On October 9, 2024, the Department referred the hearing request to the Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH). The OAH assigned Senior Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) Alison G. Webster to preside over the hearing in this matter.
- (3) On December 2, 2024 ALJ Webster conducted a prehearing conference with counsel for the parties. On December 4, 2024, ALJ Webster issued a Notice of Due Process Hearing and Rights, setting the hearing for March 13, 14, 17, and 18, 2025.
- (4) On December 10, 2024, Parent's counsel notified the OAH that Parent wished to withdraw the hearing request based on resolution of all issues in the due process complaint. Counsel for the District concurred and joined in Parent's Motion to Dismiss with Prejudice.

ORDER

Parent's request for a due process hearing has been withdrawn. The above-captioned case is dismissed with prejudice.
