FINDINGS OF FACT

- (1) On October 9, 2024, Parents filed a request for due process hearing with the Oregon Department of Education (Department) on behalf of Student alleging a denial of a free and appropriate public education (FAPE) under the Individuals with Disabilities in Education Improvement Act (IDEA) by the Salem-Keizer Public Schools (District).
- (2) On October 9, 2024, the Department referred the hearing request to the Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH). The OAH assigned Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) Alison G. Webster to preside over the hearing in this matter.
- (3) On December 3, 2024, ALJ Webster conducted a prehearing conference. Attorney Elizabeth Polay represented the District. Attorneys Anna Moritz and Whitney Hill of Cedar Law PLLC represented the Parents. On December 4, 2024, ALJ Webster issued a Notice of Due Process Hearing, setting the hearing for April 7-11, 2025.
- (4) On January 7, 2025, Parents' counsel notified the OAH that they wished to withdraw the hearing request based on resolution of all issues in the due process complaint.

ORDER

Parents' request for a due process hearing has been withdrawn. The above-captioned case is dismissed with prejudice.
