**FINDINGS OF FACT**

(1) On May 28, 2025, Parent filed a request for a due process hearing with the State Superintendent of Public Instruction on behalf of Student.

(2) On May 28, 2025, the Department of Education referred the hearing request to the Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH). The OAH assigned Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) Dove L. Gutman to preside over the hearing in this matter.

(3) On July 11, 2025, Parent notified the OAH that they wished to withdraw the hearing request based on resolution of all issues in the due process complaint.

**ORDER**

Parent's request for a due process hearing has been withdrawn and the case is dismissed with prejudice.
