**FINDINGS OF FACT**

(1) On July 8, 2025, Parent, on behalf Student, filed a request for due process hearing with the Oregon Department of Education (Department) alleging that the Portland School District 1J (the District) violated sections of the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA), 20 U.S.C § 1400 *et seq.* and the corresponding federal regulations and state administrative rules.

(2) On July 8, 2025, the Department referred the hearing request to the Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH). The OAH assigned Senior Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) Alison G. Webster to preside over the hearing in this matter.

(3) On July 23, 2025, the District filed a Motion Challenging Sufficiency of July 8, 2025 Due Process Complaint in accordance with OAR 581-015-2350, seeking dismissal of Parent's request for due process hearing.

(4) On July 28, 2025, Parent notified the OAH that she wished to withdraw the due process hearing request without prejudice.

**ORDER**

Parent's July 8, 2025 request for a due process hearing has been withdrawn. OAH Case 2025-ABC-07198 and Agency Case No. DP 25-116 is dismissed without prejudice.
