

Oregon's Long-Term Goals



40-40-20 Goal

40 percent of students to receive a bachelor's degree; 40 percent of students to receive an associate degree or certificate; and the remaining 20 percent to earn a high school diploma by the year 2025.

- We use 2015-16 as a baseline and set yearly targets to meet the goals in 2025
- Targets rise in equal increments from the baseline to the long term goal
- Goals and targets identical for all student groups

Graduation:

By 2025, 100% of students will graduate in 5 years; 92% will graduate in 4 years.
