## **Determination of Eligibility**

(1) Upon completioning of the administration of assessments and other evaluation materialsmeasures, as part of an initial evaluation or any reevaluation in accordance with OAR 251-015-2115, the school district must prepare an evaluation report. The evaluation report(s) must describe and explain the results of the evaluation conducted. -Using the evaluation report and other available data, a team must determine whether the child is a child with a disability under OAR 581-015-2130 through 581-015-2180 and the educational needs of the child.

(a) <u>The</u> team, which includes a group of qualified professionals and The team must include the parent of ← the child, must determine

(a) Whether the child is a child with a disability in accordance with OAR 581-015-2127 through 581-015-2180, OAR 581-015-2795, or OAR 581-015-2780; and

(b) The educational needs of the child., in accordance with OAR 581-015-2190, and two or more qualified professionals, at least one of whom is knowledgeable and experienced in the evaluation and education of children with the suspected disability. This team may be the child's IEP team.

(2) The school district must provide a copy of the evaluation report and the documentation of determination of eligibility at no cost to the parent.

(b) For a child suspected of having a specific learning disability, the team must meet the requirements of OAR 581-015-2170.

(35) The team may not find A a child must not be determined to be eligible for to receive special education services if:

(a) The determinant factor for that eligibility decision determination is:

(A) AL lack of appropriate instruction in reading, including the essential components of reading instruction (i.e., explicit and systematic instruction in phonemic awareness; phonics; vocabulary development; reading fluency, including oral reading skills; and reading comprehension strategies), or

(B) A lack of appropriate instruction in math; or

(B) Limited English proficiency; orand

(b) The child does not otherwise meet the eligibility criteria under OAR 581-015-2127 through 581-015-2180, OAR 581-015-2795, or OAR 581-015-2780,

(4) In interpreting evaluation data for the purpose of determining if a child is a child with a disability and the educational needs of the child, the school district must

(a) Draw upon information from a variety of sources, including aptitude and achievement tests, parent input, and teacher recommendations, as well as information about the child's physical condition, social or cultural background, and adaptive behavior; and

(b) Ensure that information obtained from all of these sources is documented and carefully
