AP and IB Examination Fees Funding Update For 2019-2020 School Year

To accelerate learning and promote equity for Oregon’s students, the Oregon State Legislature has provided funding to reduce students’ costs in taking Advanced Placement (AP) and International Baccalaureate (IB) exams.

For the 2019-2021 biennium, \$2.7 million has been allocated to enhance these accelerated learning opportunities throughout Oregon. With this funding, the Oregon Department of Education will pay for AP and IB examination fees for Oregon public school students who receive Free and Reduced Lunch. The department will also provide a subsidy for students who do not receive Free and Reduced Lunch.

The full price fees, price reduction and the cost to students are described below.
