Test Fee Program Funding Increased for 2020-2021 School Year

The Oregon State Legislature, in order to better promote equity for Oregon’s students, has increased the funding they previously provided to reduce students’ costs in taking Advanced Placement (AP) and International Baccalaureate (IB) exams.

The Oregon Department of Education can now offset all of the exam cost for students who qualify for Free and Reduced Lunch.

The full price fees, price reduction and the cost to students are described below.

There will be no stipend for students who pay standard exam fees.

2020-2021 Fees after Cost Reduction

The State of Oregon will pay for AP Exams for the following:

| Public school students who do not meet eligibility requirements for Free and Reduced Lunch | \$143 | \$0 (school may choose to apply \$9 rebate) | \$143 or \$134 if school passes on rebate to student |
| Private school students or homeschooled students who do not meet eligibility requirements for Free and Reduced Lunch | \$143 | \$0 | \$143 |
