Monthly Minute is a newsletter providing insight and tips on potential threats and hazards brought to you by your regional school emergency management professionals in partnership with the Oregon Department of Education.



Over 1 million acres burned in Oregon last year, displacing tens of thousands. At least 18 school districts suffered damage or disruptions to their facilities and learning environments.

This was an historic occurrence, but one that reinforces the need for robust preparedness efforts. Planning for wildfires ahead of time will save lives, mitigate damage and permit a faster return to normal after the fires are extinguished.

Things to consider before, during, and after a wildfire:

- Establish partnerships with organizations that will provide aid and assistance in the event of a disaster. Reach out for support on memorandums of understanding.
- Clear brush and other flammables from your facilities to prevent wildfires from intruding.

- Establish primary and alternate evacuation routes and reunification sites— if one route is blocked you will need a contingency.
- Make sure your plans include specific support for people with access and functional needs or disabilities.
- Establish a robust communications plan that will notify parents of changing conditions.
- Routinely practice your emergency evacuation drills and exercise your plan for reunification.
