The ShakeAlert Earthquake Early Warning (EEW) System can detect earthquakes so quickly that alerts can be delivered to schools before shaking arrives. EEW technology can be integrated into school paging systems, VOIP phones, computers, and fire alarm panels to automatically deliver pre-programmed alerts to students and teachers.
