Remote Learning Advisory Committee Final Report: Outcomes and Recommendations

Committee Outcomes:

- Developed and release the Online and Remote Learning Guidance in August 2023.
- Provide feedback on guidance to re-release in August 2024.
- Developed draft rubrics to support high-quality online and remote learning tied to the Online and Remote Learning Guidance.
- Developed attendance policy concepts.

Recommendations:

- Release rubrics as a companion to the guidance to support schools and districts in engaging in selfassessment.
- Publish attendance policy concepts for policy makers.
- Engage in data analysis to better understand the landscape of remote learning in Oregon
 - Qualitative data: Interviews and focus groups with students, families, and educators + school visits
 - Quantitative data: Analyze 2022-23 SY data and update the current data snapshot + explore additional data to analyze
