Dear Tribal Leaders,

The Oregon Department of Education (ODE) is honored to partner with Tribal Nations to support summer learning programs that strengthen language, culture, and community. The [State Summer Learning Tribal Grants](#) have been redesigned to reflect Tribal priorities and differ from district grants in several important ways.

### Key Features of Tribal Grants

- **Direct Funding:** Tribal grants are non-competitive and are awarded directly to federally recognized Tribal Nations that submit an application which meets the grant requirements.
- **Distinct Requirements:** Applications and program requirements are Tribal-specific, not based on school district structures.
- **Focus on Language and Culture:** Programs may center on culturally specific learning structures, language revitalization, and community engagement to increase academic outcomes for Tribal students.
- **Collaborative Planning:** ODE's Summer Learning Team will work with Tribal applicants to ensure program plans meet all objectives.
- **No Partnerships Required:** While strong partnerships within the Tribe and surrounding community are encouraged, Tribal programs are not required to have external partnerships for a successful application.

### Important Dates

- **January 13, 2026:** Application Period Opens
- **February 20, 2026:** Finalized Applications Due; Awards Announced

### Funding Details

- **Grant Amount:** Up to \$125,000 per year
