FACES (Family Academic Community and Enrichment for Success) is a project reflecting the efforts between the Falls City School District and community partners to equitably provide Falls City K-12 students enrichment opportunities, math and literacy skills, social/emotional development, and family support through high quality programming. Through research based programs and enrichment models, FACES serves K-12th grade students at two sites. In the last 15 years, FACES has been the hub of the community, connecting generations, feeding students, and communicating with service organizations across the county to meet each family's and student's needs. FACES will increase K-5 literacy achievement and social emotional learning via evidence-based programming to close the opportunity gap. FACES will continue its mission to provide math and literacy skill development, enrichment opportunities and family support to Falls City K-12 students through a collaborative partnership between community organizations and Falls City School District with a vision of a community where youth of all ages have the stability, academic support, and opportunities they need to succeed in school and beyond.
