

## **Jefferson County SD 509J**

**Funded amount \$500,000**

**Vision and Goals:** To provide equitable programming; academic enrichment and tutoring; youth development; and family engagement.

Target Population: 2,753 Jefferson County School District (JCSD) students and their families who reside in the Central Oregon communities of Metolius, Madras, and Warm Springs. 36% of our students are American Indian, 31% Latino, 30% White, and 3% other. All schools provide free breakfast/lunch, our K-8 schools are Title IA, and three schools are identified for CSI/TSI:

\*Warm Springs K-8(TSI)

\*Bridges HS(CSI)

\*Madras HS(TSI)

**Main Activities:** This is an enhanced proposal for three 21stCCLCenters, and includes additions and improvements to our current programming. Improvements informed by our current Program Reflection Results (73% or below) are marked with \*\*.

### **Major Areas of Enhancement:**

\*Support more focal group students through expanded services.

\*Increase culturally responsive programming, pd for staff.

\*Increase focus on social, emotional well-being.

\*\*Improve program administration, stakeholder engagement.

\*\*Improve recruitment, retention, and support of qualified, diverse staff.

\*\*Improve partnership engagement and communication.

\*\*Increase ongoing action planning for continuous improvement based on data reflection.

Expected Outcomes: Raise students' academic performance to meet state standards; increase student college/career readiness; engage families in education; improve students' physical and mental health.
