

2025-2026 Final Title III-A Allocations

Title III, Part A of the Elementary and Secondary Education Act, as amended by the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESEA) provides financial assistance to local education agencies (LEAs) to help ensure that English learners, including immigrant children and youth; attain English proficiency, develop high levels of academic achievement, and can meet the same challenging State academic standards that all children are expected to meet. The allocation also assists educators in cultivating educational programs for students, families, and communities.
