Thank you for your ongoing work to ensure the safe and equitable transportation of the students that attend your programs. Particularly in this year's public health situation, we appreciate your dedication to finding appropriate and compliant methods to offer transportation services to those in your care.

Annual transportation reports for the school year ending June 30, 2020 are due to the Oregon Department of Education by **September 1, 2020** as specified in state law. A complete and accurate report is essential to the process of determining and delivering the correct reimbursements from the State School Fund. Any reports received after September 1, 2020 will be considered late, and reports not received by December 31, 2020, will be considered delinquent.
