NEW HEALTH & SAFETY TRAINING REQUIREMENTS

Beginning 9/30/16 all *new* caregivers and substitutes in **Certified Child Care Centers** must complete the free online "*Introduction to Child Care Health and Safety*" training within 30 days. Staff members will receive two hours of training credit for completing the course in addition to the two hours they already receive for orientation. This training is only required to be taken once and is available in English and Spanish online with no fee at <http://campus.educadium.com/OCCD/>

All *current* caregivers and substitutes employed in a **Certified Child Care Center** must complete the online "*Introduction to Child Care Health and Safety*" training by 6/30/17.
