Goal #1	Coordinate HSS resources with CTE Revit Grant and Bond Facility funds to expand the capacity of the Vocational courses offered for students. This includes expansion of 3D printing, design engineering (CAD), and computerized metal and wood working machines for complex/precise parts fabrication.
Short-Term Outcome	Work with Contractor on a fiscally viable new shop plan and begin construction in the fall of 2021. Order new equipment/hardware, to support program and facility expansion. New facility will focus on improved Wood Shop/Carpentry electives, Metal Shop/Welding/parts design and fabrication, as well as a forestry program classroom and land lab.
Long-Term Outcome	Fully implement Forestry, Ag, and 4H curriculum expansion to include a portable mill and other forest produce processing equipment.
Dropout Prevention Activity #1	Expansion and development of overlapping brick-n-mortar and online Career and CTE themed programs designed to meet the needs of all interested students. Examples are implementation of career pathway themes and areas of focus for our K-12 Alsea Online Program, to include access to Naviance Career Interest Development Program. The staff allocations will support the career advisor and shop teacher's salary that were already supported through M98 grant.
