

## High School Success Plan 2021-2023

Goal #1	The first goal for BWA is to increase our English Language Arts Performance from the 18/19 rate of 52.6% to 58%, which would move BWA from Level 2 to Level 3. Baker Early College will focus on participation in English and Math. BEC is one of the highest performing schools in Oregon but our students often opt-out of the SBAC assessment in favor of the SAT/ACT options. Ensuring our students take the SBAC assessment will make sure we have reliable data to inform improvement efforts.
