Goal #1	85% of students will be on-track toward graduation after completing 9th grade and maintained through 10th grade.
Short-Term Outcome	9th/10th grade success teams (teachers and relevant support staff) are meeting regularly, looking at data, student supports are tracked for effectiveness and students and families are involved in the evaluation of those supports. (At the moment there is no set time for meetings to occur. Part of bargaining this year will involve created a PLC schedule for the upcoming year to provide time for this goal to be operational).
Long-Term Outcome	The overall 9th grade on-track rate of students will increase by 24%.
Dropout Prevention Activity #1	Many of the DP revolves around staffing. We have increased our mental health counseling FTE and added .5 FTE of credit recovery teaching, with a special focus on students with disabilities. The curriculum is for purchase of the Edgenuity account for credit recovery.
