<b>Goal #1</b>	Our goal at Culver high school is to have every student participate in at least one CTE/College Level credit over their four years at Culver High School.
<b>Short-Term Outcome</b>	We will increase the number of students in our identified focal group taking CTE/College Level Courses by 50%. Targeted outreach to all families, with a focus on our identified focal group. We will track and reach out to those parents that don't attend our informational nights.
<b>Long-Term Outcome</b>	By the end of the 2024-2025 school year all students will take one or more CTE/College Level credit before they graduate.
<b>Goal #2</b>	Improve our parent night participation and target our focal groups to attend and learn about the different options that are available to students beyond high school. Inform families and students in our identified groups about how to get to high wage careers.
<b>Short-Term Outcome</b>	Either through zoom or in person, create a open house or parent night to inform parents about the CTE or College courses available to our students. CTE fair during the school or after school with parent involvement.
<b>Long-Term Outcome</b>	Increase our participation rate in our informational nights to 100% and involve all students in finding out information about CTE/College or career readiness opportunities at school.
<b>Dropout Prevention Activity #1</b>	We will continue to build on what we have been doing and strengthen our Dropout prevention coordinator position. We will offer professional development and resources to help him build connections and reach the students where they are at to help bridge the gap and get students back to school.
<b>Goal(s) this activity addresses</b>	Goal 1
<b>Career Technical Education Activity #1</b>	We want to help this position continue with his education to earn his masters degree and be able to offer the courses necessary to earn the college credits for our students. To earn this we have created an 8th grade program in agriculture so our fist year students are the 8th graders from our middle school. We are focusing on our target areas of economically disadvantaged and students with disabilities to increase in these higher level classes and introducing them to career opportunities.
