Lead Organization	Dayton School District 8 - Dayton, OR
Goal #1	All students will leave 9th grade on-track and remain on track toward graduation
Short-Term Outcome	Increase the 9th on-track percentage by 10% with a focus on our identified focal groups.
Long-Term Outcome	At least 95% of all students will be on track at the end of their 9th grade year with a focus on our identified focal groups.
Goal #2	We will increase Average Daily Attendance and decrease Chronic Absenteeism
Short-Term Outcome	Decrease the chronic absenteeism percentage by 10% with a focus on our identified focal groups.
Long-Term Outcome	By the end of the 2024-25 school year, our attendance rate will be 95% or more, with a targeted focus on our identified focal groups.
Goal #3	Increase CTE/Advanced course opportunities for all students, targeting our identified focal students.
Short-Term Outcome	Currently have Agriculture and Business and currently working on Health Sciences, we plan to have it in place by the end of 2022-23. Students in our identified focal groups will be identified and targeted to participate in these classes. Our goal is to increase CTE/Advanced Course participation by 10% for all students and specifically within our identified focal groups.
Long-Term Outcome	Have a self sustaining CTE programs in terms of generating income to cover equipment, materials and supplies. Our goal is to increase participation in CTE/Advanced Courses by 10% each year, with a total of 40 % increase for all students(Especially for focal students) by the end of the 2024-25 school year.
Dropout Prevention Activity #1	Hired a dean of students at the JH/HS campus to work with students around attendance and on-track status. This person works closely with staff, students and families to support attendance and on-track status.

Dropout Prevention Activity #2	Hired a .4 FTE tech support person to train staff on the use of technology to benefit instruction in the classroom. Also train staff on the use of technology for tracking students progress. This person will also work with some students who have interest in technology and have the skills to help provide support in the IT department. Serves as our data specialist, pulling data, works with identified focal groups and students with IEP/Tech needs, does bi-lingual outreach with ELL families.
