Goal #3	Complete Phase 2 of the welding compound facility to allow for increased welding fabrication opportunities. (CTE)
Short-Term Outcome	Complete/finalize Phase 1 activities: electrical, paving and roof.
Long-Term Outcome	Fully enclose welding compound facility and install ventilation system (if funding allows).
Dropout Prevention Activity #1	Elkton High School will continue to employ a High School Success Coordinator. This coordinator will track student progress towards graduation through transcript evaluation. They will also work with community colleges and universities for placement testing, dual credit opportunities, campus visits and scholarships.
